



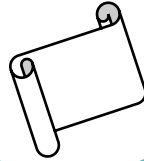
Vision A community protected from vaccine-preventable diseases.

- ▶ **Dispel vaccine myths and misinformation** with clear and concise information.



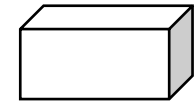
Influence public policy to protect the public's health with vaccines

- ▶ **Identify factors influencing local immunization rates** through research and collaboration with partners.
