During 2023, TIP's ability to empower legislative advocates resulted in more than 640 emails sent to lawmakers on immunization-related bills.

In 2023, TIP held statewide legislative debriefings through its "TIP Thru Texas" tour, engaging nearly 100 stakeholders across 12 cities.

TIP conducted webinars for 11 hospitals across Texas and educated **1300 medical providers**. 130 providers signed up to be advocates and educators with the program.

TIP has now educated more than 4000 Texans through its engagement with community health workers and an impactful grand rounds program.

TIP's work with the University of Houston's Community Health Worker Initiative involved hiring and training 20 part-time community health workers (CHWs). CHWs reached nearly 3,000 individuals and provided vaccine information, with 83% of clients overcoming immunization barriers.
